Dear Friends of Good Shepherd Church,

As we continue our pilgrimage through Lent, this time of remembering, returning and renewal in the faith, some random thoughts...

- Part of my ministry to serve as your transitional pastor is to help you discern how God is calling you into the future. We are in the early stages of what I trust will be a very intentional and purposeful conversation and process of decision making. This journey will be grounded and framed with study, thoughtful dialog, careful listening and openness to one another and trust in the Spirit's leading. We are called to be a community of expectant prayer. Our total Operating giving for 2017 was \$85,746 (which includes \$375 of Thrivent Funds) and was \$7,754 less than our 2017 budget and \$9,286 more than last year.

This compares to a 2016 loss of \$ 9,274.
